Lothian Buses runs a 100% low-floor fleet, meaning every bus is wheelchair accessible. If you use a wheelchair but have not been on a Lothian bus in recent years, this is your chance to come along and try-a-bus whilst it is stationary. We know some

wheelchair users are nervous of boarding a bus for the first time when it is on a "live" journey – try getting on and off the bus as much as you like without causing anyone any delay to their journey.

You can come along with your wheelchair at any time 1030-1530, but please note that the bus visit has been coordinated with Forward Mid's regular last Tuesday of the month Cafe Connect at the Dalkeith Welfare Hall [which runs from 1400 to 1530] so that you can combine a visit to the bus with a cuppa and a chat with others at Cafe Connect.
