#### **Grapevine Advice Subjects**

Grapevine provides local disability information and advice on a free, confidential and independent basis in Edinburgh. Our advice line is available for anyone to contact on 0131 475 2370 (Mon-Fri, 10am-4pm) and general email enquiries can be sent to: <a href="mailto:grapevine@lothiancil.org.uk">grapevine@lothiancil.org.uk</a> We also provide face to face appointments for disability benefit claims, outreach talks, newsletters and accessible publications.

Topics we specialise in:

#### **Benefits**

- For people of working age (16-65) we provide information on how to claim disability benefits, including reassessments, entitlement conditions and passported benefits for: **Disability Living Allowance**; **Personal Independence Payment**; Disability Premiums; **Employment and Support Allowance**; The Work Capability Assessment; Pass-ported benefits.
- Assistance is available with completing Personal Independence Payment forms with our specialist advisors, on an appointment basis (please call in advance).
- Exploration of **potential benefit entitlement for Older People** living in Edinburgh taking account of their possible entitlement to:
  Attendance Allowance; State Pension; Pension Credits, etc.
- Help is available with completing an Attendance Allowance form, which is arranged on an appointment basis

#### Benefit reconsiderations and appeals

 We can advise on challenging benefit decisions, including how to request mandatory reconsiderations (a template letter is available), and if unsuccessful how to lodge an appeal with Her Majesties Courts and Tribunal (HMCT) service and referrals to representation agencies.

#### Financial grants and money

- We can advise on financial assistance schemes to help people manage bills and household costs, e.g. energy saving, cold weather payments, foodbanks, etc.
- **Grant and trust searches** for individual people who require access to additional funding, whether it is for equipment, adaptations, holidays/short breaks, etc.






- Information about the Edinburgh City Council (CEC) Payroll Framework for disabled people who employ their own Personal Assistants
- Referrals onto Debt Counselling agencies and money advice.
- Financial support via local authority schemes such as the Scottish Welfare Fund and Discretionary Housing Payments.
- A leaflet on VAT relief for disabled people is available.

#### **Access to Transport**

- We can advise on all aspects of transport concessions, including entitlement to the: Scotland wide Bus Pass; Taxicard; Blue Badge for parking; Disabled Person's Railcard; Motability Scheme and Free Road Tax Disk.
- Local accessible transport schemes e.g. Dial a Ride; Dial a Bus and Lothian Community Transport.
- The information service also provides advice on access to travel by train, bus, plane, car and ferry.



#### **Community Care and Self-Directed Support**

- Advice on support at home, home care, Self-Directed Support options,
   Direct Payments and other options towards Independent Living.
- Advice on **Community Care Assessments**, appealing decisions if refused a service, care charging and appealing decisions on care charges.
- Information on the range of support services and care providers in Edinburgh including up-to-date List of Care Agencies in the Lothians.
- We provide referrals onto LCiL's Independent Living
   Team for specialist advice and support with individual assessments, setting up packages of care and support and employing Personal Assistants.
- Information on Short Breaks and Respite.
- Befriending options.
- Peer support groups at LCiL.

### **Housing and Adaptations**

 We can provide information on accessible housing, including information on grants for adaptations, local housing suppliers, applying for social housing, renting, buying and supported accommodation.



- Information on support with cleaning, housework, gardening, decorating, housing repairs and other domestic tasks.
- Leaflet on Council Tax Reduction scheme for disabled people.





#### **Equipment and adaptations**

- Information on assessments for equipment and adaptations.
- Information on entitlement to equipment and NHS wheelchairs
- Information on charitable trusts and grants if the person is not entitled to statutory funding for equipment, adaptations or mobility aids.
- Publications of local suppliers to purchase as well as hire equipment
- Advice on **V.A.T. relief** on equipment for disabled people.



#### **Employment and Education**

- Information on education opportunities, grants for studying, studying whilst on benefits, access to local day and evening classes, support for disabled students and help with funding for studying.
- Employment support programmes, including Access to Work, Permitted Work scheme working whilst on benefits, where to go for employment and careers advice.
- Information on employment rights under The Equality Act and where to go for specialist legal advice.
- Information on volunteering and volunteering opportunities.
- Referrals to LCiL's full range of training and learning opportunities for disabled people, Personal Assistants and organisations.

## **Holidays and Leisure**

- Information on accessible holidays, self-catering, hotel and guest houses, adventure holidays, group holidays and holidays with care provided in Scotland, the UK and abroad.
- Information on disability sports clubs, Lothian Disability Sport, Edinburgh Leisure services, gyms and swimming pools.
- accessible leisure opportunities in Edinburgh from specialist arts classes, computer classes and groups, to mainstream community education classes in schools and community centres.









- Advice on improving access for disabled people to employers, organisations and individuals, including accessing the internet and technology for disabled people.
- Access Audits, how to meet your duties under The Equality Act, or how to improve access for disabled people
- Guide on Accessible Meeting Places in Edinburgh and the Lothians.
- Sign posting on improving access and the built environment.
- We offer specialist advice on providing accessible information and formats available. This includes Scottish Accessible Information Forum (SAIF) standards.
- We can provide disabled people with RADAR keys at the standard fee of £3 or £3.50 (inc. P&P). Please call to arrange in advance.

#### Disability Equality and the Law

- General information on the rights of disabled people under The Equality Act and information on where to get further advice if you feel that you have been discriminated against.
- Advice on how to access various organisational complaint procedures.
- Referrals onto independent legal agencies.

#### **Health and Personal Issues**

- Information on NHS services, counselling services, support services for people experiencing mental health issues and those in crisis, for example during relationship breakdown or bereavement.
- Publication on Emotional Support Services in Edinburgh and the Lothians.
- We also have information on self-management courses and impairment specific support organisations and groups, e.g.: the MS Society, Arthritis Care, Parkinsons UK. etc.
